5. Harbor Master Report by Don Jones - We have 50 feet of additional dock space and a total of 24 slots. The dock has been mated to the existing dock and all the pilings are set. Concrete weights, chains, pulleys, and buoys for the eight additional eight moorings are on hand. A work party is planned for Saturday after regatta. All dock members are being emailed the seniority list and a form to fill out for their choice of mooring slot (3 choices in case of conflict).
