1. The meeting was called to order at 7:10 P.M. by Commodore Matt Crawford.

2. Commodores Report by Matt Crawford:

- Kevin LeMay invited everyone to his and Ashley's wedding on July 31st.
- Bill Riner thanked everyone for their participation and help with the C-15 Nationals.
- Debi Merrill brought in another pirate flag and asked everyone to guess whose flag it was. Richard Merrill guessed that it was Matt's flag. The flag was given to Matt Crawford.

3. Treasurer's Report by Debi Merrill: Unavailable at this time.
