

## HYC Water-Front Boat Parking Rules

### Purpose

The purpose of this document is to provide a set of rules to guide HYC members in the use of limited water-front boat parking spaces, thereby reducing conflict within the membership and providing a means for long-term planning.

### I. Parking Space Assignment Criteria

Boat parking spaces will be allocated only to HYC members in good standing which have met the following conditions:

- a. The applicant has on record with the HYC Port Captain proof of liability insurance as required by the HYC Constitution.
- b. The applicant has applied, in writing, with the Port Captain for a parking space and has established a seniority date.
- c. All associated club fees have been paid – past and present.
- d. The sailboat has current State Registration.

### II. Parking Space Identification

The available water-front parking spaces are defined as follows:

- a. A total of eleven parking spaces are established. Eight parking spaces along the water front starting at the ramp to the boat dock and heading west. Three parking spaces at the west edge of the water front and heading east.
- b. No additional water front parking spaces are open.
- c. Initial assignment will be per the established order of boats that were parked at the end of the 1998 sailing season. Boats owners are identified as (from the east, on the east side of the site): Cayce, Wright, Ranstrom, Bussche, Hailey, Utley, Utley, Woronowicz and (from the east, on the west side of the site) Henninger, Stevens, Barnett.

### III. Seniority

A list of seniority dates, for the purpose of space allocation will be maintained by the HYC Port Captain. The initial space allocation will be as stated in II.c. above. This seniority list will establish a waiting list in the event that more than eleven boats have current applications for spaces. Seniority dates for those members desiring parking spaces will be determined as follows:

- a. Members who owned sailboats and utilized a parking space at the end of the 1998 sailing season will be the date that they joined the HYC.
- b. Members who own a sailboat and desire a parking space will be the date they applied with the Port Captain for a space.
- c. Members who do not own a sailboat will be the date they applied with the Port Captain for a space, but they are subject to space denial criteria stated below.

#### IV. Space Denial Criteria

- a. An HYC member that becomes eligible for a space and does not own a sailboat has 30 days to purchase a sailboat or show proof a sailboat is on order. Failure to do so will forfeit the priority date and he will be required to reapply. The earliest new seniority date will be that on which reapplication was made.
- b. The right to a site is waived if the member does not respond to the Port Captain's offer of a site within two weeks from the time of notification or he specifically waives his right at the time of the offer.

#### V. Renewal of Site Allocation

Assignment of parking spaces in order of seniority will be conducted each year during the month of January. The Port Captain will record and publish a list of assigned spaces each year. Only HYC members meeting all Parking Space Assignment Criteria by December 31 of the previous year will be considered for parking spaces.

#### VI. Parking Fees

Parking space fees will be assessed for the purpose of maintenance and improvement of the parking areas and purchase of associated equipment. Fees will be billed by the HYC treasurer and are due with the annual club dues. Members forfeiting a space will be reimbursed on a pro rata basis. Expenditures of these moneys will be by a majority vote of members having parking spaces or as deemed necessary by the Port Captain and approved by the Commodore. Fees will be reviewed periodically by the executive committee. Initial parking fees are:

Beach-Front Parking Space:                      \$50 per year

#### VII. Sailboat Restrictions

- a. Sailboats longer than 19 feet will not be assigned beach-front parking sites.
- b. All sailboats must be in sailable condition.

#### VIII. Site Etiquette

- a. HYC members will be limited to only one parking space unless vacant spaces are available.
- b. In the event a space will be left unoccupied for a period of time, the member to whom the site is assigned is encouraged to share his site with other members on the basis of seniority date.
- c. Members not planning to sail for an extended period are encouraged to vacate their site.
